Maryland Proposed Bill References ASHRAE Standards for Indoor Air Quality

Maryland House Bill 900, regarding new occupational safety and health standards as well as indoor air quality standards for public buildings in the state, was introduced earlier this month in the state legislature. It would require a new comprehensive indoor air quality standard for public buildings, including school buildings, be developed before 2025. This standard must be consistent with evidence-based consensus air quality standards such as [ASHRAE Standard 55, Thermal Environmental Conditions for Human Occupancy](#), and [Standard 62.1, Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality](#). The bill will be under consideration by the House Environment and Transportation Committee at a hearing on March 9.

Lehigh Engineers Unveil Thermal Battery for Decarbonization Applications

In the ramp up to more widespread renewable energy use, thermal energy storage is becoming a go-to solution for enabling power grids to respond to variable supply and demand conditions. Now Lehigh engineers, with support from the Department of Energy, have developed a new thermal energy system, the Lehigh Thermal Battery. The technology consists of engineered cementitious materials and thermosiphons in a combination that enables fast and efficient thermal performance at low cost. It is capable of operating with heat or electricity as the charging energy input. After three years
