### Mulligans

- \$5 per Mulligan (max 8 per team)
- If you need an extra shot, one player takes that extra shot and it costs a mulligan. If another extra shot is taken, that uses another mulligan. A mulligan doesn't mean all 4 players take another shot from the same spot for the cost of one mulligan.

## **Skirts**

- \$5 per Skirt (max 1 per team)
- One individual to tee off from one red tee box on a hole of their choice.
- If the individual is a women (normally teeing off on red tee box) the Skirt will function as a Mulligan allowing 1 shot for that individual person.

#### **Strings**

- \$10 for one string (5 foot long) (max 1 string per team)
- Use the string to basically make a putt/shot that you already missed.
- Example: If your entire team putts a 30 footer (or any type of shot for that matter) and you have three feet left, you can measure and cut off the 3 feet of the string from opposite the knot end, then the 30 footer is considered made and you take the score as if you made that original putt. Your team then has two more feet of string to use on another (or multiple) shots where you have less than two feet left over. The knot is there so you know which string is still "alive" after a cut is made, and you have pieces of cut string laying in the cart from previous shots.
