He has served as an ASHRAE Distinguished Lecturer, chair of the International Standards Advisory Subcommittee and vice chair of the ASHRAE Epidemic Task Force, among other extensive involvement, and is the recipient of several ASHRAE awards.

Knight is the founder of Whole Building Systems, LLC, Mount Pleasant, S.C., and his experience in the design, construction, operation and maintenance of high performance buildings spans over 46 years. He has commissioned hundreds of new buildings and audited or retro-commissioned over 100 million ft² (9.3 million m²) of existing commercial, federal and industrial building stock.
