### Panel Discussion – Kentucky Building Code Task Force Update

**When:** Oct 15, 12-1pm

**Summary:** BCE Director Gary Feck and his staff will give an update on these efforts as the subject of our next Chapter Meeting. Please plan to attend, and come with questions!

**Context:** The Housing, Buildings, and Construction (HBC) Advisory Committee formed a Task Force in 2024 to explore the updating of Kentucky's Building Codes. The Bluegrass ASHRAE Government Affairs Chair, Doug Cage, has been attending the HBC Advisory quarterly meetings and Task Force events to observe and facilitate any needed technology transfer between ASHRAE and the Task Force-

This includes:

- A two hour presentation on ASHRAE Standard 90.1 (an alternative compliance method to IECC) by the Chair of the Standard, Richard Lord
- The provision of copies of ASHRAE 90.1 & 90.2 to the HBC office of Building Code Enforcement (BCE)
- The coordination of IECC discussions and recommendations among the American Institute of Architects (AIA) and some ASHRAE members
- Providing input to the Task Force
